## Ms. Neela Thakur

- Great first month of school
- Pleas for PTO help:
- Hip Hop Program - 60 minute performance / all school assembly at the end of the school year (June). 4 day program - $\$ 1,950$. Additional performance would be extra. Neela to check on price of one show.
- Professional signage (similar to Webb's) -
- 4 PTO members (Beth, Nathalie, Darka, Karen) viewed signage with Neela. Thanked PTO members for joining her at Webb.
- Neela showed pictures of the signage at Webb. 10 around the school. Signage made of sturdy thick plastic materials in the main corridor, outside of the main office, around the entrance of the school, door wraps, and large hanging banners with school colors, school principles and inspirational messages.
- Merritt Graphics in Hartford created the signage at Webb. Asking PTO if anyone interested in coordinating the process, shopping around or going with the recommended company.
- Neela to find out if mounting and hardware is included. PTO asked for package price or options to present at next PTO meeting. Neela to look into this. For the quantity of banners at Webb, Neela estimated $\$ 3000-\$ 4000$ (Webb PTO paid half).
- Stop and Shop - Neela mentioned approximately $\$ 2000$ goes into escrow account. Will get back to PTO on the actual amount in the EW Stop and Shop account.
- EW Music Department Team Update - music team working on a few items:
- Wolf Pack hockey game - Friday $3 / 18$. Band and Orchestra will play.
- Hartford Yard Goats - Tuesday 05/31. Chorus will sing the National Anthem. EW school students to sing national anthem $-5^{\text {th }}$ or $6^{\text {th }}$ grade or both. Neela to find out. This event could be a fundraiser or just a fun activity. Need someone from PTO to organize or help. Reach out to Neela / Ms. Fox. This event could be part of $6^{\text {th }}$ grade committee ( $6^{\text {th }}$ grade events). Question about how far in advance we have to schedule the event. Colleen and Diana volunteered to help.
- First Lockdown Drill - practiced first lockdown and bus evacuation drill of the year. First one was announced. Kids did a good job. Director of security and 2 Wethersfield Police officers were present. Kids practice these drills many times per year. Encouraged PTO to ask children their impression of how well the drill went.
- Introduced $3^{\text {rd }}$ Grade Team - SBAC test results. Third grade English and math - students tested higher than anyone in district and state average. Third grade had highest level of special education students and did extremely well. Teachers did exceptional job between not stressing and preparing them well and had a good balance about taking the test seriously but not too
seriously. Encouraged children to do their best but shouldn't be nervous or anxious. Way test administered has impact on how well kids do and these teachers did an excellent job.

- The fall book fair made $\$ 1,787.12$ profit on $\$ 7,955.37$ in sales, though online orders are still coming in (Scholastic will send us a check for our share). $\$ 60$ less than last year but on budget because we have less students.
- Holiday Store - negative for now. Purchasing of stock for the store.
- Quick books - purchase of $\$ 202.05$
- The portion of PTO funds dedicated to the instrumental scholarship now stands at \$1,550.47.
