Ms. Neela Thakur

- SBAC state testing this month for grades 3-6:
  - o All students have completed the English Language Arts portion of the test and will complete the Math component by 5/20.
  - o 3 sub-components (over 2 hours of testing) were eliminated this year.
  - Students used computerized tests and Chrome books for testing.
  - o Testing will be completed by the end of May with scores available in October.
- Board of Ed and Town council meeting:
  - \$500,000-\$600,000 from the Wethersfield budget may be cut. We will know which line items will not be approved in approximately one week.
  - Not receiving security officer position.
  - Keeping Mrs. Intino position hours.
  - o Grade 6 will have 3 teachers instead of 2 teachers for the current 49 students in grade 5.

  - Asked parents to complete 4 questions by Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. Results will be shared with the PTO at the June meeting.

**Future Projects** 

Colleen Mattatall

- K-1 Playscape Replacement:
  - o Board of Education approved the playground project on 4/26.
  - o Town Council made a formal referral to Planning & Zoning Commission on 5/2.
  - Next Steps:
    - Playscape replacement to be presented to Planning & Zoning Commission on 5/17.
    - Reported to Town Council for final acceptance of the donation of the playground on 6/6.
    - If Planning and Zoning needs to formally re-address any item, a second discussion will take place on 6/7.
    - If all dates above are met, sign the playground contract with Creative Recreation and order the equipment (pay for the equipment) in early June.
    - The playground company projects take 30 days to receive the order and to begin work.
    - After completion and town inspection of the work/install, we will pay the remainder of the costs.
  - After inspection of the plans, the town determined that we need to add an accessible wood fiber path making the playground up to code and ADA compliant. There is an additional cost of \$1600 to the project bringing the total cost to \$38,504.
  - Completion date: End of July (tentative).
