Teacher Representative

Carissa Mierzejewski, EW Social Worker, Buddy Bench Jennifer Kardys, 4th Grade Teacher, EW Leadership Team

- Buddy benches now installed on both playgrounds. Good for support and problem solving and empathy on playground. 6th grade made video and teachers created visuals in the classroom to show kids how to use it. 6th graders showing younger kids how to use the buddy bench and answer questions / explain how to use it.
- School wide bookclub
 - o Overall bookclub topic was chosen by the EW leadership team bookclub.
 - Every other month we have a specific book with the theme 'A Growth Mindset,' where the book supports the idea that its ok to take risks and keep trying.
 - Each grade will read the same book and will be involved in an activity involving the book, not tied to curriculum, to foster a love of reading. Grades will pair up for fun projects and act out the book, keeping in mind its ok to just try something. Read the book in October and activity in November.
 - Request for help to fund remainder of books. Neela has purchased the book 'The Bear Ate My Sandwich.' Need \$400 for 3-4 new books to continue with the book club for the rest of the year. \$16-17 per book. EW leadership team is currently voting on the books to be used for the year by 10/14. 1 book needed per grade level (8 copies of each book needed).

- Several suggestions already provided. Here are the suggestions and the PTO board responses:
 - 1. Suggestion 1:

Anonymous: As an EW parent and PTO Member, I propose that the destination of the funds received from the Stop & Shop cards be changed from going to the school escrow account to going to the EW PTO general fund. I'm satisfied with being able to obtain financial information from EW PTO. It's clear to me what the money is being spent on and I am answered when I have a question. I am not satisfied with the money going into the school escrow account and not being accounted for to the EW parents that raised it. This should be a simple vote of the PTO members in attendance at the next meeting.

Response: From the Stop and Shop A+ Rewards website. Can the PTA/PTO register with their Tax Identification Number (TIN)? No. Only schools can participate in A+ School Rewards. All checks are written in the school's name. It is crucial to submit the correct TIN (Tax Identification Number) when registering, as the reward payment at the end of the program will be reported for 1099 purposes.

2. Suggestion 2:

Anonymous: Can we update the PTO Officer section of the web site to show their photos? And, can we keep a history of past board members on in this section, by school year please?

Response: We've added the past 4 board years and have elected to not include photos of the current board.

3. Suggestion 3:

Anonymous: I suggest having a WSPC section of our website. If they are the 'PTO' for the town of Wethersfield, we should be supporting one another and promoting their website in a section of ours.

There will be a sheet of suggested enrichment activities to go with each book. Each class will pair up with a class in a different grade level to do the activities related to the book, once they have read the book in their classroom. Our Leadership Team, with the guidance of our Literacy Curriculum Specialist, will be choosing the books. The books will stay with the grade level, and one will be housed in the Library. We believe she was trying to find all books with a Growth Mindset type of a theme. They have asked if we would consider funding this project of approximately \$400 which would purchase 8 copies of each of the 5 books they read this year. PTO to fund \$400 for 8 copies of 5 books (1 for each grade level and 1 for library). Motioned by Jaime Rogalski and seconded by Autumn Struk. Approved.
