## Officers' Reports

### **Principal's Remarks**

Ms. Neela Thakur

- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade fundraiser for CCMC (EW Dance at Wethersfield High School): Thank you to the 6<sup>th</sup> grade students, Mrs. Reynolds, and Camie Mollica, for raising \$2719 as part of an UConn fundraiser for CCMC. The students surpassed their \$1000 fundraising goal. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will join UConn students to present the money raised during Husky Event (dance marathon).
- Mr. Emmett presents the first draft of next year's school budget on 2/13. The budget will be
  voted on at the 2/27 or 3/13 meeting, before going to the town council for approval. Mr.
  Emmett's budget will have slight increase for teacher salary and insurance cost with no new
  initiatives.
- 2 EW administrative positions were cut this past year (Literacy Director for the entire school district) and STEM Director (for the entire school district).
- Many areas have district wide positions to lead the entire school district. We don't have those
  positions. We have a Special Education Director, Special Education Supervisor, and Technology
  Director (for the entire school district), Literacy Curriculum Specialist (shared between EW and
  Webb) and Content Area Curriculum Specialist (shared between EW and Webb).
- Neela encouraged speaking at the Town Council or Board of Education meetings.
- At the last Board of Education meeting, Mr. Emmett announced a 10-year long initiative to look into closing, renovating, or redistricting the elementary schools. A company was hired to analyze all of our school buildings.
- 3/20 and 3/22 are both half-days (parent-teacher conferences).
