Tiger Topics Health Tips

To maintain good dental health, here are a few tips to keep that smile healthy.



Snacking causes release of plaque bacteria. When the bacteria meets up with sugars and starches from your snack it creates an acid that causes a "plaque attack" on your teeth. Each "plaque attack" can last 20 minutes, thus leaving your teeth exposed to developing cavities.

To prevent cavities:

- Brushing after each meal or snack is, of course, the best defense.
- Reduce the number of times you snack during the day.
- When you snack, eat your entire snack at one time so you don't expose your teeth to too many "plaque attacks." If you eat some of your snack now and some in an hour, you will have two "plaque attacks" instead of one.
- Choose healthy foods and drinks to snack on. Candy and sweets as well as soda and fruity juices contain sugar which means more plaque bacteria which means more "plaque attacks."
- Cheese can be a very beneficial snack for your teeth it disrupts the development of cavities especially as a snack or after a meal.
- Have your teeth cleaned twice a year.


