I hope everyone had a great holiday season and enjoyed the Winter Vacation with the children. Our new year is starting off great! We are experiencing a little bit of difficulty in the afternoon, so I would like to remind everyone about the importance of following the proper car pickup procedure at dismissal time. As you approach our school coming up from Wells Road, please be sure to proceed directly into the school parking lot and then pick up your child along the curb / sidewalk within our school parking lot. Your child should stand on the sidewalk near the large playscape and look out for your car. It is not acceptable to actually pull over on Wells Road and have your child walk to Wells Road to meet you. You need to keep your car moving along Wells Road, as the cars ahead of you progress up when students get picked up and head out. Do not pull over on Wells Road, as it creates a dangerous situation for our students and a dangerous situation for other vehicles travelling on Wells Road. Please note that the Wethersfield Police Department will be issuing tickets to cars that are pulled over intentionally on Wells Road during our bus dismissal time. I know you all consider the safety of our students to be the highest priority. I thank you all for your strict adherence to this important afternoon dismissal procedure.


