A Message from Mrs. Richard, EW Art Department

The EW Art Show is quickly approaching! If you are available for any amount of time to help mount the last few classes of artwork and help with labels, please let me know and I can have everything ready to go for you! Also, this year I thought it would be fun to try 1-3 interactive stations for families. I have a few ideas, but am totally open to any suggestions. Not every station would need someone there, but I think it would be great if we could have a few parent volunteers do a 15 minute rotation to help with the supplies.

One idea was a big family portrait wall. We could draw frames on big bulletin board paper and kids and parents could create a portrait inside one using crayons or colored pencils. Another was "What inspires you" where everyone could take a post it note and write or draw something that inspires them and stick it to the designated decorated wall area. Finally, I was thinking of a fan letter station where parents could write a letter to their child, or kids could write one to another student. In the art room, we discuss critiquing artwork and being very specific about what you like about the art and why, and also thinking of a question for the artist. They would be delivered the week after the show. I think another cute idea is a scavenger hunt worksheet that could be handed out or left by the entrance. Something small and handheld. Everything on the list would connect to the lessons/art in the show.
