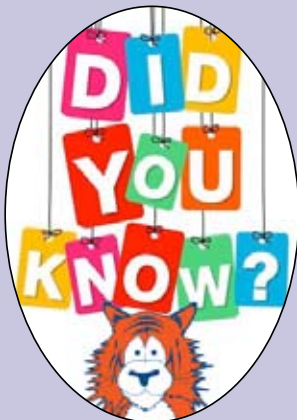
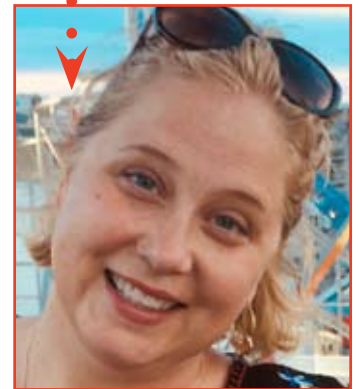

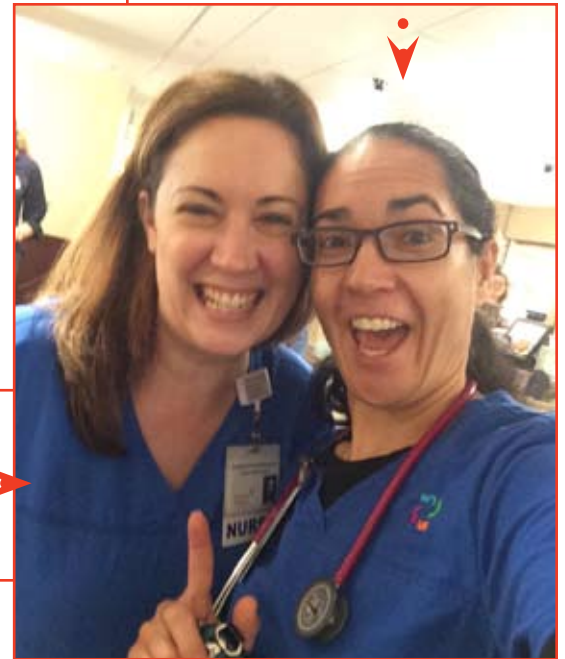

Do you have to be a parent of a student to volunteer for EWPTO? Can grandparents, family friends, etc. volunteer?

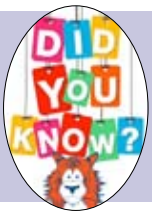
We welcome anyone to volunteer for the PTO who shares the common goal of advancing Emerson-Williams Elementary School.

Committees

Bingo: Committee members are involved in soliciting prizes, set-up, checking of bingo cards, distribution of prizes, raffle and refreshments.

Book Fair: Committee members are involved in the set-up of books, assisting children in previewing and purchasing books. The book fairs occur in the fall and possibly in spring if there is interest. *Scheduled to occur in September.*

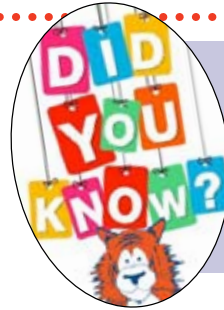
Cheer/Teacher Appreciation: This committee consists of obtaining cards and gifts to recognize events in the life of school staff, and putting together a luncheon for Teacher Appreciation week and small monthly signs of appreciation.

Community Outreach: Committee members organize different community outreach opportunities for E-W to participate in. Examples: collection of food, cleaning products, or personal hygiene items. Coordinate with Wethersfield Social Services or other local organization. *Occurs in sporadically throughout the year as needed.*

Copy Crew: Individuals who can come into the school and make copies for the entire school on an as-needed basis. Random texts are sent to all members and whoever can make it, can reply to all and volunteer. *Occurs in sporadically throughout the year as needed.*

Dance: Committee members create a beautiful dance at our school. Kids invite their Someone Special whether it be a grandmother, grandfather, mother, father, uncle, aunt, or step-parent. *Typically occurs in the Winter or Spring.*

Fundraiser - Holiday Store: This family event provides students with an opportunity to shop for their family. Committee members shop for gifts, decorate, help students shop, and help wrap purchased gifts. *Typically occurs in November.*

Fundraiser - Manager: Research and organize schedule fundraisers for the following school year for the PTO.

Fundraiser - Mixed Bags Designs: A committee member establishes and runs fundraising project to raise funds for the general PTO fund. *Typically occurs in April.*

Fundraiser - UCONN Game: A committee member works with UCONN to schedule a date and market the event. *Typically occurs in the winter.*

Fundraiser - Vendor Night: Committee members plan and implement this fundraising event in which vendors purchase table space for an evening of shopping by E-W families and community members. *Typically occurs in November or December.*

Fundraiser - Yard Goats Game: A committee member works with company for key dates and schedule and market event. *Occurs in the spring.*

Room Parents: Members of this committee solicit volunteers for room parents and coordinate the assigning of these volunteers to classrooms under the policy set forth by the PTO in September.

TV Turnoff Week: Committee Members organize activities and projects to do during a full week to promote no TV watching for the week. *Typically coincides with National TV Turn Off Week in April.*

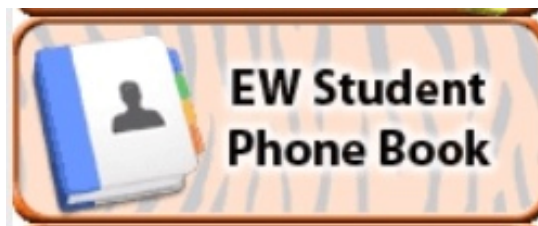
