Hello Emerson-Williams community,

My father, who was born in Greece, would roast pork over an open spit. I tried to keep that tradition alive by having our main meal of pork in the oven (I really don't want to dig a hole in my yard. Plus, have you seen 'My Big Fat Greek Wedding'... pork in the front yard, I tell you. No thanks.).



I usually make a Greek dessert of 'Galaktoboureko', made of semolina custard in filo dough coated with sweet syrup, or 'bougatsa' which is similar sans the syrup. In Greece back in the day, presents were brought to children by Ayloc Basily (Saint Basil) on the 1st January. There are many other traditions for the Christmas season, but I won't go on.



Committees

Beautification: Collaborates with the principle on ideas or ways to improve the school's appearance and then implements those ideas.

Boon Supply (Mixed Bag Designs): Committee oversees distributing order forms, collecting payment, and then distributing purchased items to families.

Copy Crew: This committee is on call for printing copies when needed. Individuals who can come into the school and make copies for the entire school on an as-needed basis.
