

<u>MASKS</u>: Getting a mask to stay up over our nose or stay out our mouth, especially when we talk, can be a challenge. It may take trying a few different styles of masks to find the ones that work. Pleated masks help to keep the mask away from the mouth and ear loops that have adjusters can help to tighten the mask in order to prevent it from falling down below the nose. Remember to wash the masks daily after use and to remind your children and family to carry an extra mask as a backup.
