Also, below is a reminder regarding the Wethersfield Public School's COVID Guidance. Please remember to check your child with a home COVID test if they are experiencing mild cold or allergy symptoms or are not feeling well prior to sending them to school. Test kits are available for pick up by

contacting the school nurse or main office. Please note the expiration date of the kits has been extended and now have an expiration date of <u>January 2023</u>.

COVID and Sick Guidance

Test-Mask-Go Strategy

With allergy seasons and New England Winters we will utilize this strategy for *MILD* respiratory symptoms to continue to attend school:

- Fever free <100°
- Wear a mask consistently and correctly
- Test negative everyday that they have symptoms prior to reporting to school, as well as one final test when symptoms have resolved

Mild symptoms: infrequent cough, congestion, runny nose, sore throat, etc.

TEST KITS AVAILABLE!!!

Fever >100°:

- Must stay home until fever free for 24 hours without medication
- · Must have a negative test

If your child is sick, please keep them home for the health and safety of all students and staff.

Positive COVID cases still need to isolate. Please let the school nurse know and she will provide guidance.

If you are unsure if you should send them to school, please contact the school nurse.
