Dollars for Scholars: Colleen

It was discussed that Dollars for Scholars provides scholarships for students who reside in Wethersfield ONLY. A few years ago, a few WHS students started a nonprofit: The Primary Project which provides scholarship money for the Choice Students. The PTO gives \$375 to both scholarships each year.

- EW teachers voted to give to only the Primary Project
- In the future if people wanted to, the PTO could vote to change who the money is given to.
- We were told to write emails to Dollars for Scholars to express our opinions on the matter, if we feel strongly about who they should give the money to.

Items to vote on:

- Add line item to budget in admin line: The budget was created in April and voted on in May. However, we did not factor in money for the website expenses (\$250) which is billed in July or August of each year. Colleen made a motion to add this line item into the budget, Shane seconded the motion, all were in favor. Line item added to budget.
- 2. October PTO minutes: Colleen made a motion to approve the October minutes, Lauren seconded the motion, all were in favor. Minutes approved.
- 3. Mrs. Dalke Wishlist. Christen explained that Mrs. Dalke was asking for 6 bowling pin backstrips for her bowling unit. These would help students not spend so much time running around gathering the pins after they bowled. It was discussed that Mrs. Dalke serves all the kids in the school, during COVID she did not ask to use any of her Wishlist money and passed it onto the music department. Shana made the motion to allow the PTO to pay for this expense outside of the Wishlist account, Amy B. seconded, all were in favor. 6 bowling pin backstrips passed.
