BOARD of EDUCATION UPDATE: Jim Reilly

- Budget workshop will be held on $2 / 25$
- The referendum did not pass so now a new enrollment study is needed.
- Next referendum will hopefully take place in the spring of 2024
- Charles Wright improvement would cost $\$ 40$ million but would not be approved by the state for reimbursement. BOE should follow up and see why C.W. is not getting the full reimbursement allowed
- The state usually reimburses $56 \%$ of the cost for renovations and $46 \%$ of the cost for new builds.
- People were curious as to how buildings have been maintained
- Request for Proposals: BOE might need to go with another company other than Colliers.
