HOW WE SUCCEED:



WHY WE FUNDRAISE!

Throughout the year, it may feel like the PTO is always fundraising – and on some level, we are! We know that our families support our school community many ways, not just through monetary fundraising, but we want to give you a clearer picture of why we raise funds throughout the year.




Last year, our school community raised over \$17,000 to help fulfill the PTO's mission! Of this amount, roughly 7% went to fees we need to run the PTO (website costs, QuickBooks, signage supplies, etc.). Roughly 16% went to Community Donations, including scholarship donations for graduating seniors and to the Creative Arts Council, which brought in the amazing hip-hop residency program! 32% of funds raised paid for events and projects like the beatification of the blacktops, the color run, and the donation to the 6th graders for their events. **Almost half of our funds, 45%**, went to the school! Including: staff support, cheer, read for the record, poetry afternoon, instrument adapters for the 3rd graders to try out instruments post-covid, classroom needs through the wishlist, among others!




