- BoE & WSPC: Anthony
  - Budget issues for town will impact SPED but is also dependent upon the State Budget and how much they will contribute to each town.
  - Board is proposing 7.33% increase
- Book fair: Andrea & Lauren
  - Kick off today: Wish list day
  - Need more volunteers
  - Could we give volunteers incentive for volunteering?
  - Need to make paying for the books equitable for ALL teachers
  - Need to pump up helping out those students who may not be able to afford getting a book, not just a little line at the very end of a ParentSquare message
